**ONLINE**

Courses can be taken online during the summer in an accelerated 8-week session. The same content is covered as a full residential course, and the same amount of credit hours is earned for completion of an online summer course.

**RESIDENTIAL SESSIONS**

Courses can be taken residentially during the summer in one of two 4-week sessions. Summer residential courses are quicker, meeting daily for longer periods of time than the typical fall or spring terms. Participating Dual Enrolled students are not permitted to live in Residence Halls.

**PREREQUISITES**

Courses with prerequisites—requiring transfer credit for or the completion of a previous course—are specified with an asterisk (\*). Please keep this in mind when selecting courses for Dual Enrollment.
